

# **Water Department**

"How make to an ACH (Automated Clearing House) payment"

ACH payments are done electronically. They help relieve the hassles of writing a check, an envelope and the expense of a stamp. Also, you are helping the environment. This type of payment requires a computer. If you do not have a computer then visit your bank and they will set it up for you.

#### As you requested, here are the instructions...

Log into your bank account:

1. Select: BILL PAY

2. Type **company** name: **BMRPOA** 

3. Type **company** address: POB 797

Stanhope, NJ 07874

4. \*Type your account #: 99 Lockwood\*

(example)

5. Select a date to pay: 10/10/2015\*

(example)

6. Type amount to pay: (balance due) or (1/3 of your bill by the 25th of each month)

\*NOTE: your account number is vour address. No need to include the words: Street, Avenue, Road, etc., this information is not necessary.

If you have any questions, please call the office for guidance. Many members are utilizing this payment method and it is working smoothly.

Other Types of Payments: You may continue to pay your bills by mailing a check or by calling the office and using a credit card (Visa or Master Card).

#### ABOUT the new Invoice...

Notice the bottom section of your invoice. If you see there is a prior open balance then add that balance to the Invoice total.

-ALSO, remember to add the \$40 late fee if your envelope is post marked after the due date or the ACH is posted after the due date.
