### WATER DEPARTMENT NEWS

#### Billing Schedules

Please mark your calendars for the quarterly Water Department bills. They are delivered on the first of January, April, July, and October.

As a reminder, you have 30 days to pay your bill in full or you may use the “Easy Pay” plan. Split your bill by 3 payments. Paying 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of your bill no later than the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month. If payment is received on the 26<sup>th</sup> of the month it will be considered late.

Accounts that remain unpaid past the due dates are in delinquent status and will be charged a late non-payment fee of \$40. Delinquent customers will have 10 business days to satisfy their bill or be subject to water service interruption.

Also, mark your calendar for the annual Association bill which is dispersed on May 1st.

Payment is due in 30 days unless adopting the “Easy Pay” plan as this payment is due no later than the 25<sup>th</sup>. Non-payment of Association and Water bills can result in a lien placed on the property in the county clerk’s office of Newton.

#### NEW Water Department Equipment

We have begun changing radios again, throughout West Brookwood as the COVID-19 has been slowing down and safety precautions have been instituted.

Appointments will be scheduled with the homeowner for the technician, Chris Basile to enter your property. He will be changing the radio that in most instances is attached to the outside of your house. He may need to access the water meter that is in your home if the radio does not communicate with the meter.

This means you have an ABB or a non-working meter. In this instance, he will have to replace the existing meter. This will be at the cost of the water department, not the homeowner. Please allow him access to our equipment in your home to complete the job in a timely manner. Time is allotted at each home to complete the job.

If you have a scheduled appointment and need to make a change then kindly, call or email the office to reschedule.
