#### From your Water Department...

We are using an Automation Text messaging system to notify members quickly during a water emergency. And is an outgoing message only. One member of each household will be notified of an emergency via a text message. This is provided at no cost to membership.

If you are not currently receiving emergency water outages text messages, please provide the following information to the office via email to <a href="mailto:bmrpoa@gmail.com">bmrpoa@gmail.com</a>: Name, Address and Mobile Number.

#### **REMINDERS:**

- Water Service Invoices are billed quarterly on the 1st of January, April, July, and October.
- Association Dues Invoices are billed annually on the 1st of May.
- Bills are emailed (outbound only) from <u>brmpoa@quikwaters.com</u>. Include this email address in your contacts to assure your invoice is delivered to your inbox (not your Spam folder).
- Full payment is due by the end of the month unless you choose the monthly EZ-Pay plan.
- EZ-Pay Plan: Divide your bill by 3 payments and pay that amount monthly. Payments must be received by the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month.

Actual Usage as of April 1, 2006 Residential------\$3.20 per 1,000 Gallons Commercial ------\$4.80 per 1,000 Gallons

#### Service Fees:

Meter tampering is subject to prosecution.

Members of the BMRPOA include well and lot owners. When a builder or homeowner wants to hook up to the water system, there is an application and a connection fee.

Membership dues are currently \$25.00 per year for each taxable lot. To receive water service, you must be an Association member in good standing.
