Water Department News...

WBWD

The Water Department is currently testing and also lowering curb stops that are raised above ground level. We are doing this to prevent costly repairs when damage is done by others to our equipment.

Customers do not have a choice in this matter. This point is not debatable with the Water Department by a customer. We are lowering the valve stem/cap to ground level or just below for the following reasons:

- 1. To prevent damage to stem/cap when lawns are cut that result in costly repairs.
- 2. To eliminate a tripping hazard.
- 3. And, foremost to adhere to code.

The curb stops are not on homeowner's property but are located on a Water Department easement and for that reason no notification is required. However, before any work is done, as part of our standard Water Department procedure the Field Tech will ring your door bell. We have over 400 curb stops to inspect and many have been addressed during the hot summer months.
