WATER DEPARTMENT

~ Please note, it is important to notify the Water Department if you plan to sell your home to avoid delaying the sale for a final water reading. The water department needs to work with the attorneys and title agency to close your account and open a new account for the buyers.

~ Test your shut-off valves in the house to make sure they work. There should be 2 shut-off valves on your water service line. One before and one after the meter. Reason being, if you have a leak in the house, you should be able to turn your water off immediately. Thus, preventing water damage and preserving water.
