WATER DEPARTMENT NEWS

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR BILLING

Water Department bills quarterly on the first of January, April, July and October. You have 30 days to pay your bill in full or use the Easy Pay Plan by paying 1/3 of the bill by the 25th of each month.

Accounts that remain 31+ days past the due date are in delinquent status and will be charged a non-payment fee of \$40. Delinquent customers will have 10 business days to satisfy their bill or be subject to termination of water service.

Association bills annually on the first of May. Payment is due in 30 days. Non-payment of association and water bills can result in a lien placed on the property in the county clerk's office in Newton.

NEW METER EQUIPMENT

We are changing radios throughout West Brookwood because the company MARS has stopped making radios.

You may notice our technician, Chris Basile entering your property to change the radio that in most instances is attached to the outside of your house. There may be times when he may have to access the water meter that is in your house if the radio does not communicate with the meter.

This means you have an ABB meter. In this instance, he will need to replace the ABB meter too. Please allow him access to complete his job and in a timely manner. Time is allotted at each home to complete the job.

If you have a scheduled appointment and need to make a change then kindly call or email the office to reschedule.
