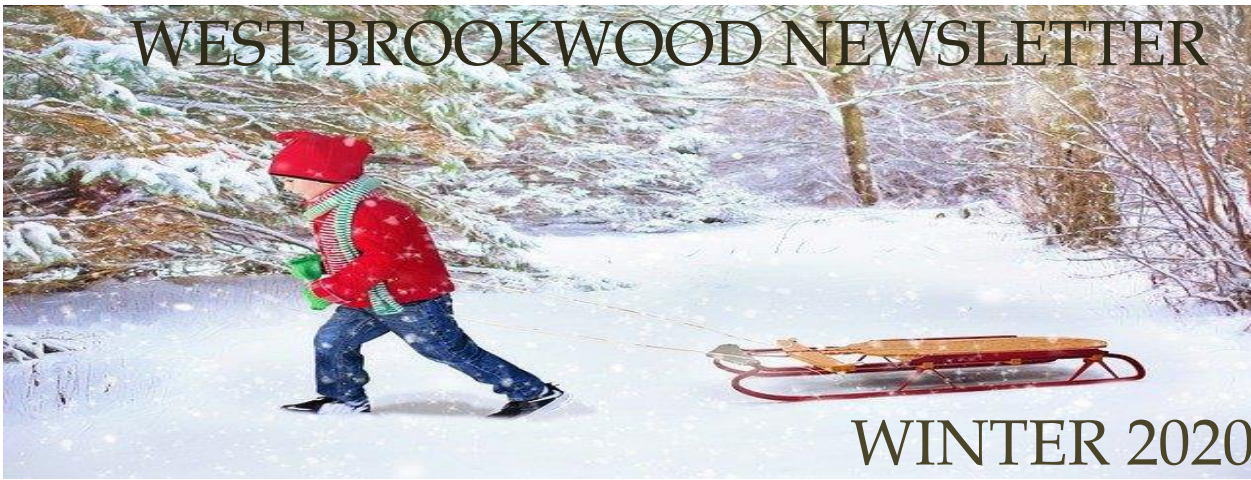

**The River Road Generator** has been replaced and during electrical outages has been working successfully.
